### **Hug Cards**

### **MATERIALS NEEDED:**

- construction paper
- scissors
- glue
- markers
- googly eyes (optional)
- glitter (optional)

#### **DIRECTIONS:**

- 1. Fold one piece of construction paper to create two flaps with the middle section a little bit larger.
- 2. Have the kids trace their hands onto another piece of construction paper. Younger kids might need a little help with this step.
- 3. Cut out a heart, the hand shapes, and two long rectangles which will be the arms.
- 4. Glue the heart to the middle section inside the card.
- 5. Next, glue the hands to the arms. Glue one arm on each side of the heart. Create a face on the heart.
- 6. Decorate the inside and outside of the card with markers, glitter, etc.
- 7. Sign your name.


### **MATERIALS:**

- Construction paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- Markers or foam letters

### **DIRECTIONS:**

- 1. Cut out a big heart (You can trace it and let children cut it out)
- 2. Glue the heart in the middle of a piece of construction paper
- 3. Fold a piece of paper in half and trace both hands. (You want two of each hand, so you may need two pieces of paper.)
- 4. Glue the two right hands on both sides of the right side of the paper (so it is visible when the card is opened and closed) repeat on the left.
- 5. Use some stickers or markers to add the sentiment inside.
- 6. Sign your name.
